Dalapro Wood Finish Plus is a ready-mixed, extra fine hand filler for woodwork. Use the product for filling frames, doors, hatches and suchlike indoors. Good adhesion, strength and building properties make the smoothed surface an excellent base coat for woodwork and enamel paint. White color. Nordic Ecolabelled.

Product specification

Packaging: 200 ml and 400 ml tubes. 3 litre plastic bucket.

Dalapro Wood Finish Plus 3 litre is packaged in a bucket manufactured in 100 % recyclable plastic and consists of at least 90 % recycled plastic.

All calculations of the packaging material is made with the 3 litre bucket that represent the majority of the market.

Allocation:

The allocation is made in accordance with the provisions of EN 15804. Incoming energy and water and waste production in-house is allocated equally among all products through mass allocation. 
Data quality:
